- 4. When at all possible, draw from observation.
- 5. Stay away from cartoons, super heroes, Japanese animation, etc.

A. Your sketchbook will be based on a <u>THEME OR CONCEPT OF YOUR CHOICE</u>.

- You will be developing this theme creatively throughout the entire school year.
- B. Surface concepts: proportion, composition and creativity.
- C. Underlying concepts: You need to understand that it takes discipline and organization to meet deadlines not only in school but out in the world. The other underlying concept is this is also a source of material for in class projects and for understanding the structure of objects.
