Your Sketchbook is a personal journey. It allows others to see your; *Thinking*, Feelings, **Interests**, Expressions, **Progress** and **EXPERIENCES**. First and foremost your sketchbook is for YOU! Always remember that. There are however, certain elements that help make a strong sketchbook. You should keep the following in mind as you work.

- 1. Work to fill in the entire page, touch all four rider of your paper.
- 2. USE BOTH SIDES OF THE PAPER
- 3. Do not tear out any pages. You can paint over, or paste over a page.
- 4. When at all possible, draw from observation.
- 5. Stay away from cartoons, super heroes, Japanese animation, etc.
- 6. EXPERIMENT, TAKE RISKS.

Concepts to be learned:

- A. Surface concepts: proportion, composition and creativity.
- B. Underlying concepts: You need to understand that it takes discipline and organization to meet deadlines not only in school but out in the world. The other underlying concept is this is also a source of material for in class projects and for understanding the structure of objects.
- C. Media: You have a choice of media. You can use pencil, colored pencils, felt-tip markers, ink, watercolor, computer programs, or any other media that suits your needs.
