- 4. Summarize the article in your own words, in one paragraph minimum. DO NOT PLAGARIZE.
- 5. Analyze the article. This is your opinion of what you read. Did you agree or disagree with what the author had to say? Explain in detail using historical and/or factual information to support your opinion.
- 6. Type and submit on or before: Tuesday, October 18, 2011

## Writing – "The Bill"

You will be writing and proposing "your bill" for our mock Congress.

We are currently in the 112th Congress, 1st Session.

The bill must be typewritten, no more than 2 pages in length. It must discuss why there is a need for the law and who/what would benefit from the law.
