- _____ 2. Present proof of college-ready scores* on the FCAT, ACT, SAT, or PERT (*only 2 attempts allowed on PERT*)
- _____ 3. Go to high school advisor/guidance counselor and obtain a **Dual Enrollment Approval Form**
 - A. Complete student and parent/legal guardian information (signature required)
 - B. Select MDC Course, reference #, course title, and H.S. requirement met
 - C. Obtain signature of High school counselor and principal
 - D. Apply the High school seal

FCAT and PERT

- Score report must be submitted to MDC in a sealed envelope with the stamp/seal of the high school.

ACT and SAT

- Scores must be submitted from the College Board directly to MDC (electronically).
