Students Don't Have to Wait Anymore

On the morning of January 26th a letter from the Student Rights Committee was presented to the manager of the 7-Eleven food store on Miller Road. The letter attacked 7-Eleven's policy of making students wait outside the store during SMSH's three lunch periods while allowing non-students to enter. "If the policy did not change," the letter stated, "a boycott of 7-Eleven would begin that afternoon." Apparently, the committee was successful, for that afternoon the store

had already discontinued its policy of making students wait. "We certainly hope it lasts," said a Student Rights Committee spokesperson. "Otherwise, we will have to put on the pressure again. But the 7-Eleven manager seemed pleased about the way things were working out. Before he had to monitor the door, and now he can work behind the counter or monitor the aisles." As seen above, students are no longer required to wait outside.
